



## Adult Vocational Training Allocation FY 2010-11 (AVT)

- All tribal members will be afforded an equal opportunity to apply for these one-time funds.
- Students will be awarded up to **\$5,000** per applicant to attend an accredited vocational training program or school. This program is limited to the special council allocation.
- The application period will open September 15, 2010 and close on October 15, 2010. The application must be post marked by October 15, 2010.
- A committee will be involved in the selection process.

### The following Adult Vocational Training (AVT) Requirements must be met to be considered for funding:

- A completed AVT Adult Vocational Training Application must be submitted.
- The institute or program must be accredited. The accreditation agency is to be a national reputable or regional reputable accrediting agency. Accreditation is not the same as certificated. For more info: <http://www2.ed.gov/admins/finaid/accred/index.html>
- Applicants must provide a detailed budget with their application from the school.
- Expenses can include the school's tuition, fees, books and training materials. Travel and lodging can be a part of the award. Lodging & travel expenses will be paid to a vendor.
- The length of the training program must be indicated.
- Applicants must show proof that they applied for their FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at: <http://www.fafsa.com>
- An acceptance letter from the accredited AVT training program or school.
- Applicants will be limited to this special award one time only. Students who received an AVT award in the past, are not eligible to apply.
- Continuing education applicants or current higher education college degree applicants will not be eligible for this special allocation.
