**NO DETECTION OF RADIATION  
FROM THE  
JAPANESE NUCLEAR DISASTER**

The Environmental Program collected seaweed from the rocks at Trinidad and had the University of California at Berkely's Nuclear Department test it. The results came back that there is **no detection** of any radioactive elements, including Iodine 131.

Also, US EPA is monitoring the air, drinking water, milk, and precipitation for environmental radiation on an ongoing basis since the Japanese disaster. To-date atmospheric levels recorded at the Eureka, CA have been *thousands* of times BELOW any threshold known to impact public health.

Yurok Tribal Staff is following the data VERY CLOSELY and working with international, federal, and state agencies and will continue testing seaweed over the next month.
