### Environmental Program

Depending on weather conditions, Burning is expected to start around **February 12th and end around February 24th.**



In the Interest of exercising the Yurok Tribe's jurisdiction over air resources of the Yurok Indian Reservation. The Yurok Tribe Environmental Program is collecting public comments regarding proposed approval of Yurok Tribal Burn Permits for cultural burning at various locations in the vicinity of the Weitchpec Transfer Station & Lake Prairie communities located on the Yurok Indian reservation.

YTEP is especially concerned about those who are at greatest risk from smoke exposure such as:

Elders, Pregnant Women, Young Children, or those how have health problems such as:

Asthma, Heart Disease, or Respiratory Disease and may be effected by this proposed burning.

*Sensitive populations should remain indoors and avoid rigorous physical activity during times of elevated smoke.*
