As a part of Domestic Violence Awareness month, the Silent Witness Project is on Display today, Monday October 17, 2011 and tomorrow Tuesday October 18, 2011 in the Main Tribal Office's lobby.

The Silent Witness project was created to honor those victims who have been murdered in the acts of Intimate Partner Violence (aka Domestic Violence). They feature life-sized black silhouettes and create a chance for the community to understand the potential lethality of intimate partner violence and the devastation that it causes families as well as communities.

We hope to raise awareness by having these silhouettes on display and create the realization that intimate partner violence is serious, can be lethal and is a part of our community. We encourage everyone to come and check the display out!

The first our two community awareness events will be next Friday October 21, 2011 at the Weitchpec Tribal Office from 5:00-8:00pm.
