



Three Natural Resource Student Intern Positions

The Yurok Tribe recently received funding from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (by way of the Klamath River Intertribal Fish and Water Commission) for three student intern positions in the field of

Natural Resources; candidates must be between 16 and 23 years of age. The intent of these positions is to provide employment and an opportunity for students to explore potential career choices in the field of Natural Resources. Positions are being offered in the Fisheries and Environmental Programs, and the Heritage Preservation Office. Positions will begin in early July and run through August (up to eight weeks), dependent upon the fall semester schedule of the intern.
