Questions and Answers:

1. Question: Since the project is federally funded are there prevailing wage requirements?

Answer: There are no Prevailing Wage requirements for this project.

2. Question: What is the Tribe's preferred format for the Pricing Schedule?

Answer: There is no required format. Please submit your company's standard/general price schedule. It does not need to be developed specifically to suit this solicitation.

3. Question: Since the number of sites is between unknown (17 to 30), will a "Price per Site" or "Hourly Labor Price" be acceptable?

Answer: We are not requiring project-specific pricing at this time, we just need your company's general price schedule and will use that information to evaluate your proposal.

4. Question: Would it be acceptable to individually price the four sections within the scope of work?

Answer: Yes, we are looking for the hourly wages for each activity i.e. PV design, PV assessment, electrical assessment, etc.

5. Question: Will there be a partial building department reviewing our construction documents?

Answer: The Tribe's Planning Department will be reviewing the construction documents.

6. Question: If there is a code approval process, will all sites be submitted, reviewed, and possibly approved individually or collectively?

Answer: Code review will be conducted by the Yurok Tribe Planning Department and all sites will be reviewed individually.

7. Question: Will the oral interviews be over the phone, via video conference, or in person?

Answer: Oral interviews will be conducted via Microsoft Teams.

8. Question: Should a single representative or all key team members be present during the oral interview?

Answer: All key members are encouraged to take part in the oral interviews.



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9. Question: Is there flexibility to reschedule oral interviews based on the availability of team.

Answer: There may be some flexibility to reschedule oral interviews during the week of July 15, depending upon the availability of the review team.

10. Question: We operate under a CA C-10 contractors license. Is that suffice or is the C-46 mandatory as well?

Answer: A CA C-10 contractor's license will be sufficient.

11. Question: Would it be preferred that the solar array tracks with the sun or are fixed arrays preferred?

Answer: The Tribe is open to all options that will allow for a low-maintenance, cost-effective system.
