Tribal Member Comment:

Good afternoon. This is Elizabeth Davis. I have a comment on the two individuals that will be banished. I'd like to know if there's going to be any type of hotline or some way for individuals to report sightings of the individuals and some type of communication with law enforcement and maybe some kind of public notification on how to get ahold of law enforcement.

45 Celinda Gonzales: I feel like DC definitely need to be gone from our reservation. They're already
46 have a lifetime ban from the Hoopa reservation. They were both involved in the deaths on the
47 Hoopa Reservation, and not just the one Yurok tribal member. And I've seen where one was in
48 housing up in Crescent City. I think that you guys are doing a good thing and I would like to see
49 both of them banned.

51 Cecillia Moore: I'd like to make a comment. This is very great news. Also. I'm hoping that with
52 these two individuals being see in other tribal housing, that those people who continue to
53 house them will also have consequences. For fully knowing that these two are no longer
54 welcomed, then those people should have consequences as well.

56 Rosie Clayburn: I really support this decision and I think it's a really good step in the right
57 direction for protecting our people. We all know that this is a huge issue on the reservation and
58 in our ancestral territory in general. I fully support the idea of having a tip line or hot line. Not
59 only directed at these two individuals, but also others. We all know that these people are
60 everywhere. There are a lot more than these two and, you know, these drug houses run up and
61 down the river and it's time that we stop it. I am very proud of Council for taking a step in the
62 right direction.
