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1.0 INTRODUCTION

Freshwater Environmental Services (FES) has prepared this Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (Phase I ESA) on the former Tulley Creek illegal dump site, located near the end of Tulley Creek Road, near Weitchpec, California (hereinafter referred to as the Site, or Subject Property). This Phase I ESA was prepared for the exclusive use the Yurok Tribe located in Klamath, California and the United Stated Environmental protection (USEPA) Region 9 Brownfields Program.

This Phase I ESA conforms to the principles of ASTM E 1527-05 "Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessments: Phase I Environmental Site Assessment Process" (ASTM, 2005).

This report is organized as recommended in ASTM E1527-05.

1.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Phase I ESA is to identify Recognized Environmental Conditions (RECs) associated with the Subject Property. An REC is defined by ASTM as the presence or likely presence of any hazardous substance or petroleum products on a property under conditions that indicate an existing release, a past release or a material threat of release of any hazardous substances or petroleum products in the structures of the property or into the ground, groundwater, or surface water of the property. The term includes hazardous substances and petroleum products even under conditions in compliance with law.

This report will include listing of historic RECs, if applicable. A historical REC is an environmental condition which, in the past would have been considered a REC, but which may or may not be considered a REC currently.

RECs do not include de minimis conditions that generally do not present a threat to human health or the environment and that generally would not be subject to any enforcement action if brought to the attention of appropriate government agencies.

1.2 Detailed Scope of Work

This Phase I ESA conforms to the principles of work described in ASTM E1527–05.

1.3 Significant Assumptions

It is assumed that the groundwater flow direction in the vicinity of the Subject Property is to the east towards the Klamath River, based on the moderately sloping topography in the area.

1.4 Limitations and Exceptions

"No environmental site assessment can wholly eliminate uncertainty regarding the potential for recognized environmental conditions in connection with a property. Performance of this practice is intended to reduce, but not eliminate, uncertainty regarding the potential for recognized environmental conditions in connection with the property." (ASTM, 2005). The information included in this report is based on professional opinions from our field reconnaissance and visual observations of the Subject Property and our review and interpretation of available historic information as described in this report.

1.5 Special Terms and Conditions

No special terms or conditions are related to this investigation.

1.6 User Reliance

This report was prepared for the sole and exclusive use of the Yurok Tribe located in Klamath, California and the USEPA Region 9 Brownfields Program. The scope of work performed in this investigation may not be appropriate to satisfy the needs of others. Any use or reuse of this document and findings is at the sole risk of said user.

2.0 SITE DESCRIPTION

2.1 Location and Legal Description

The Subject property is located in the general vicinity of the end of Tulley Creek Road near Weitchpec, Humboldt County, California. The Subject Property is located approximately one half mile west of the Klamath River.

The location of the parcels that contains the Subject Property is outlined in Figures 1-6. Some portions of the parcels that were inaccessible due to dense vegetation growth were not inspected or included as part of this investigation. The Subject Property in this report includes the areas of the parcel that were pointed out as previous waste disposal areas by Yurok Tribal representatives. Areas inspected are shown in Figures 1-6.

The majority of the Subject Property is included in Assessor Parcel Number (APN) 534-182-015 in Humboldt County which is owned by the Yurok Tribe. A small portion of the Subject Property may extend onto the north adjacent parcel, which is indicated as APN 534-182-009. The ownership if this parcel is unknown. According to information provided by Parcel Quest, the Yurok Tribe purchased APN 534-182-015 in 1996. The parcel map that includes the Subject Property is included in Figure 2.

2.2 Site and Vicinity General Characteristics

The Subject Property is currently vacant undeveloped land on the Yurok Indian Reservation. The main portion of the Subject Property is cleared with little vegetation and a primarily gravel surface. The property is surrounded by dense forest and vegetation. Areas surrounding the Subject Property include dense vegetation with sporadic residential dwellings. The Klamath River is located approximately one half mile to the west.

2.3 Current Use of the Property

The Subject Property is currently vacant undeveloped land.

2.4 Description of Structures, Roads, Other Improvements on the Site

The majority of the Subject Property is vacant undeveloped property. It is accessible from Tulley Creek Road, which is a dirt and gravel road, and is gated in the vicinity of the entrance to the Subject Property. There are no structures on the Subject Property. The road continues to the north, through the Subject Property, and ends near the north edge of the Subject Property.

2.5 Current Uses of Adjoining Properties

Currently, the uses of the adjoining properties include primarily vacant vegetated land and residential properties.

3.0 USER PROVIDED INFORMATION

3.1 Title Records

Mr. Ken Henderson, user of the report, indicated that no property transaction is in progress, therefore, a title report has not been ordered.

3.2 Environmental Liens or Activity and Use Limitations

The user of this report, Mr. Ken Henderson, representing the Yurok Tribe Environmental Program, was not aware of any environmental liens or activity and use limitations. A search conducted by Environmental Data Resources, Inc. (EDR) did not indicate the presence of any environmental liens or activity use limitations on the Subject Property. A copy of the legal description for the grant deed searched, which is based on the parcel number of the Subject Property, is also included in the report. According to the Grant Deed recording supplied with the lien search documentation, the Yurok Tribe acquired the Subject Property (APN 534-182-01) along with numerous other parcels in the vicinity of the Subject Property in 1996. Prior to 1996, the land is indicated as being owned by Gregory J. Koppola and R. Cook Enterprises, Inc. The report also indicates that various logging companies have had rights to the land for logging and building roads as necessary. A copy of the EDR search results is included in Appendix A.

3.3 Specialized Knowledge

Mr. Ken Henderson, user of this report, was not aware of any specialized knowledge related to the Subject Property other than that it was used for illegal dumping, trash burning and possible manufacturing of methamphetamine.

3.4 Public Outreach Meeting Results

An essential part of the Phase I ESAs is the collection of historical knowledge directly from Yurok Tribal members about each of the Brownfields sites including the former Tulley Creek dumpsite. FES has facilitated and participated in two Tribal District Meetings for the purpose of public education regarding the Brownfields Program, providing status reports on the four project sites and collecting historical information regarding the previous uses and activities on the four Brownfields properties. Maps and aerial photographs of the Brownfields sites were provided prior to and during the meetings and the participants were encouraged to note information directly onto the maps and photographs, as well completing the questionnaire to capture information from the community.

The district meetings at Weitchpec and Pecwan were attended on June 29, 2009. Attendees indicated that the "dump site" was actually the residence of an individual that was described as a "collector". The attendees referred to the Subject Property as the "Abbott Dump". None of the attendees recognized or know the use of an aboveground storage tank located on the Subject Property. Some attendees speculated that it may have been used for water or fuel storage for use in local logging operations. There were

general rumors regarding methamphetamine labs in the area and waste entering the creeks. No additional information was provided about the Subject Property.

3.5 Commonly Known or Reasonably Ascertainable Information

Mr. Ken Henderson, user of this report, indicated that the property was formerly used as an illegal dumpsite. The Yurok Tribe and the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) removed the majority of the trash and debris in October 2008. Mr. Henderson noted that various types of debris had been dumped on the Subject Property, including several dozen vehicles and travel trailers, industrial and general use batteries, burned debris, used motor oil, unlabeled containers that may have contained fuel and/or solvents, tires, household debris, etc. He noted that the majority of the dumping occurred in the southern portion of the Subject Property, near the entrance to the property where Tulley Creek Road ends (Figure 5). A flat area further north was primarily used for a residence (Figure 5). Another area of concern was to the northeast, where Mr. Henderson noted the potential former presence of methamphetamine labs and associated waste (Figure 5).

3.6 Valuation Reduction for Environmental Issues

Mr. Ken Henderson, user of this report, indicated that no property transaction is underway and no purchase price has been identified for the Subject Property. The property is being considered for future residential development for the Yurok Tribe.

3.7 Owner, Property Manager and Occupant Information

Mr. Ken Henderson, representative of the Subject Property owner, the Yurok Tribe, provided responses to an environmental questionnaire. The completed questionnaire is included in Appendix B. Mr. Henderson indicated that the Subject Property was previously utilized as an illegal dump, including petroleum products, batteries, and various other items. Mr. Henderson indicated that the Yurok Tribe is the owner of the Subject Property but he is unaware of the length of time that the Tribe has been owner. According to title records obtained from EDR and Parcel Quest, the Tribe has owned the property since 1996.

3.8 Reason for Performing Phase I ESA

Mr. Ken Henderson, user of this report, indicated that the reason for performing a Phase I ESA is to ensure that contamination does not threaten public health and the environment during and after redevelopment of the Subject Property. The Yurok Tribe has selected this Site to be evaluated under the USEPA Brownfields Program.

4.0 RECORDS REVIEW

4.1 Standard Environmental Record Sources

FES contracted with Environmental Data Resources (EDR), a company specializing in the acquisition and compilation of local state and federal environmental records, to acquire the ASTM required records. EDR has provided a Radius Map Report, which is provided in Appendix C. EDR searched the Subject Property and surrounding area for standard environmental records as required by ASTM E1527-05. The search radius for each database complies with ASTM E1527-05. A complete listing of the databases searched and the radius searched are included in the EDR Radius map report.

The Subject Property is not listed on any of the databases reviewed by the EDR report. Other sites listed in the EDR report include the following:

 The Yurok Reservation does not have a listed address and is listed on the "Indian Reservation" database indicating the presence of Indian administered lands that have an area of greater than or equal to 640 acres.

Other sites listed in the EDR Radius Map report are unlikely to have a negative impact on the Subject Property due to distance from the Subject Property, groundwater flow direction, and the reported environmental activities.

4.2 Additional Environmental Record Sources

A database report listing sites with environmental activities in Humboldt County was provided by the Humboldt County Division of Environmental Health. Based on a review of the list, there are no additional properties of environmental concern in the area of the Subject Property.

4.3 Physical Setting Sources

The 1982 United States Geologic Survey (USGS) 7.5 minute topographic map entitled Johnsons, California, which includes the Subject Property and surrounding area was reviewed and is included in Figure 3. The Subject Property has an elevation of approximately 560 feet above mean sea level. The residence is on a flat area that was probably carved into the hillside. The topography in the area around the Subject Property generally slopes steeply to the east. The nearest stream shown on the USGS topographic map is Waukell Creek which transects the Subject Property.

The Subject Property is shown on the "Geologic Map of the Weed Quadrangle, California" (Wagner and Saucedo, 1987) as being underlain by the South Fork Mountain Schist. The Geocon investigation reported that the visible outcrops in the vicinity of the Subject Property "appeared to be composed of interbedded slaty to schistose metasedimentary rocks" which is in general agreement with the Geologic Map cited above. The nearest fault zoned as active (within the last 11,000 years) under the Alquist-Priolo Earthquake Fault Zoning Act, is approximately 22 miles southwest of the Subject Property.

4.4 Historical Use Information on the Property

Information in this section of the report is based on acquisition and review of various historical sources including historic aerial photographs, historic topographic maps, and interviews with local officials. City directory data and Sanborn Fire Insurance maps were not available with coverage for the Subject Property.

Based on a review of historical data sources, the oldest documentation is a 1947 aerial photograph that indicates the Subject Property was heavily vegetated with no development. Areas of the Subject Property are visibly cleared beginning in the 1970s. It is unknown when illegal dumping began on the Subject Property. Some evidence of illegal dumping is evident in a 2005 aerial photograph.

4.4.1 EDR Historic Aerial Photographs

Aerial photographs from 1947, 1954, 1974, 1988, 1993, and 2005 were provided by EDR. Copies of the aerial photographs are included Appendix D. The aerial photographs were reviewed and the following observations were made:

1947: Due to heavy vegetation, no features are evident on the Subject Property.

1954: Due to heavy vegetation, no features are evident on the Subject Property.

1974: A cleared area is visible on the Subject Property which may have been associated with a gravel pit. Due to the quality of the photograph and heavy vegetation, no other features are distinguishable.

1988: Tulley Creek Road is visible on the Subject Property. No other features are evident due to heavy vegetation.

1993: Tulley Creek Road is visible on the Subject Property. No other features are evident due to heavy vegetation.

2005: A clearing is visible at the end of Tulley Creek Road. The clearing does not appear to be vacant and is likely being used for junk disposal, though specific features are not distinguishable.

4.4.2 Other Historic Aerial Photographs

One aerial photograph dated June 22, 1948, was reviewed at Humboldt County Public Works Department. The aerial photograph was reviewed and no features are evident on the Subject Property due to heavy vegetation growth.

4.4.3 Historic Topographic Maps

Historic topographic maps from 1947, 1952, 1982, and 1997 (photo revised) of the Subject Property and surrounding area were provided by EDR. In 1947 and 1952, Tulley Creek Road does not extend as far north as it does currently. It appears to dead end into the Klamath River approximately 2 miles southwest of its current endpoint.

Currently, there appears to a be a turn off of Tulley Creek Road that leads to the former dead end, which appears to have a building present, which is likely a residence. On the 1982 and 1997 maps, Tulley Creek Road appears to be in its current configuration. Both maps indicate the presence of a residence at the end of the road. According to Mr. Ken Henderson, a residence was formerly located at the end of the road, but was in severe disrepair and was demolished at the time that the illegal dump was cleaned up. A gravel pit is also shown on the 1982 and 1997 maps, near the end of Tulley Creek Road. Copies of the historic topographic maps are included in Appendix E.

4.4.4 Historic City Directories

Historic city directory data was not available with coverage for the town of Weitchpec.

4.4.5 Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps

Historic Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps were not available with coverage for the Subject Property. Documentation of the lack of coverage is included in Appendix F.

4.5 Historical Use Information on Adjoining Properties

Based on historical information, adjacent properties have remained undeveloped with the exception of scattered residences.

5.0 SITE RECONNAISSANCE

5.1 Methodology and Limiting Conditions

The Subject Property was inspected by Orrin Plocher, Stan Thiesen and Julie Savona of FES on May 7, 2009 and on June 1, 2009. FES was escorted by Mr. Ken Henderson and Ms. Kate Sloan of the Yurok Tribe Environmental Program. Mr. Henderson and Ms. Sloan pointed out the areas of concern where the majority of the dumping occurred. The Subject Property is currently vacant undeveloped property. There are no structures present on the property. The entire Subject Property was viewed. Photographs from the Site inspection are included in Appendix G.

5.2 General Site Setting

Currently the Subject Property consists of vacant undeveloped land. Though the majority of trash and debris has been removed, remnants left from former illegal dumping are evident throughout the property. The area surrounding the Subject Property is heavily vegetated and in some areas, swampy. The main dumping area on the Subject Property is relatively flat, though the topography in general in the area slopes moderately to the east, towards the Klamath River.

5.3 Exterior Observations

Currently the Subject Property consists of vacant undeveloped land. Some trash, including an old engine block, tires, household debris, and old UST labeled "potable water," is still present scattered in various locations across the Subject Property. The majority of the Subject Property, where the main dumping occurred, has been cleared and has a gravel surface. The former location of a house is currently a gravel pad. A former logging road provides access to another area northeast of the main dumping area where a methamphetamine lab may have been previously located.

5.4 Interior Observations

There are no structures on the Subject Property.

6.0 INTERVIEWS

6.1 Interview with Owners

The representative of the owner of Subject Property, Mr. Ken Henderson, provided responses to an environmental questionnaire. A copy of the questionnaire is contained in Appendix B. Mr. Henderson indicated that the property was previously used for illegal dumping including various types of hazardous waste. He is unaware of any additional potential environmental issues in the vicinity of the Subject Property.

6.2 Interview with Site Manager

Mr. Ken Henderson, representative of the Site owner, is also the Site manager, as described in Section 6.1.

6.3 Interviews with Occupants

There are no occupants on the Subject Property.

6.4 Interviews with Local Government Officials

FES interviewed Mr. Norm Crawford, of the Humboldt County Department of Health and Human Services. Mr. Crawford is not aware of any environmental concerns in the vicinity of the Subject Property. He is not aware of the former presence of an illegal dump on the Subject Property.

Mr. Ken Henderson provided information that was obtained from the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) regarding disposal of waste from the Subject Property. Mr. Todd Thalhamer, of the CIWMB, indicated that approximately 168 tons of solid waste was removed from the property. In addition, 145 tires, 15 appliances, and 15 cathode ray televisions were removed. With regard to hazardous waste, Mr. Thalhamer indicated that the following was removed: 3 gallons of petroleum related liquid waste, 6 gallons of flammable liquid, 60 pounds of flammable solids, 127 pounds of poison solids, 36 auto batteries, and 400 pounds of batteries classified as a Federal hazardous waste under the Resource Conservation Recovery Act (RCRA).

Mr. Thalhamer indicated that during the clean up process, five areas were discovered where someone was burning wastes. These areas were removed and sampled to ensure that metals contamination was removed. The excavations were to the satisfaction of the EPA and CIWMB. Mr. Thalhamer indicated that analytical results did not indicate contaminants above levels of concern.

7.0 FINDINGS

This assessment has identified the following environmental findings:

- The Subject Property has been historically used for illegal dumping. In addition, at least one illegal residence was located on the Subject Property.
- The majority of the waste on the Subject Property was removed by the Yurok Tribe and the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) in October 2008. According to CIWMB records, the following waste was removed: approximately 168 tons of solid waste, 145 tires, 15 appliances, 15 cathode ray televisions, 3 gallons of petroleum related liquid waste, 6 gallons of flammable liquid, 60 pounds of flammable solids, 127 pounds of poison solids, 36 auto batteries, and 400 pounds of RCRA batteries. In addition, the CIWMB indicated that during the clean-up process, five areas were discovered where someone was burning wastes. These areas were removed and sampled to ensure that metals contamination was removed. A report with the results of the sampling is in the process of being prepared but was not available at the time of this report.
- A large tank that may have previously been a UST is located on the Subject Property. The tank is labeled "potable water" on one end. The actual use of the tank is unknown. According to attendees of a public meeting, it may have been used for water or fuel for logging operations in the vicinity, or else as a water source for residents of the Subject Property.
- An area northeast of the main dumping area was reportedly used for methamphetamine production, potentially releasing toxic chemicals into the environment.

8.0 OPINION

Based on information obtained from this investigation, the potential exists for subsurface impact from various types of hazardous wastes in multiple locations throughout the Subject Property, including potential impact from illegal dumping, trash burning and illegal methamphetamine production.

Qualifications of the environmental professionals that prepared this report are included in Appendix H.

9.0 CONCLUSIONS

We have performed a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment in conformance with the scope and limitations of ASTM E 1527-05 at the Tulley Creek former illegal dumpsite (portions of APN 534-18-215) near Weitchpec, Humboldt County, California. Any exceptions to, or deletions from, this practice are described in Section 2 of this report. This assessment has revealed the following recognized environmental conditions in connection with the property:

- Former use of the Subject Property for illegal dumping, including solid waste, tires, appliances, liquid waste (petroleum related materials), flammable liquid, flammable solids, poison solids, auto batteries, and RCRA batteries. There is also a discarded UST on the Subject Property.
- Former use of Subject Property for illegal waste burning. Five separate areas were discovered. These areas were removed and sampled to ensure that metals contamination was removed. A report with the results of the sampling is in the process of being prepared but was not available at the time of this report.
- Potential former use of an area in the northeast section of the Subject Property for methamphetamine production.

This assessment has not revealed any historical recognized environmental conditions in connection with the property.

10.0 DEVIATIONS

There were no significant deviations from ASTM E 1527-05.

11.0 ADDITIONAL SERVICES

No additional environmental services were provided under this contract.










Figure 2 Parcel Map









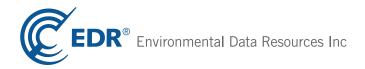

- 1. Groundwater flow direction, and
- 2. Groundwater flow velocity.


