POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the general supervision of the Jet Boat Captain, this position is responsible for assisting the Jet Boat Captain to carry out all normal deck department duties aboard the boat such as anchoring, lookout, and safety of passengers. The entire crew must work together to accomplish the task of maintaining a safe, efficient and enjoyable workplace and therefore no crewmember is above any work needing to be done to meet this overall goal. The Jet Boat Deckhand will assist the Jet Boat Captain for the operation of providing river ferry transit services. Under the direction of the Jet Boat Captain the Deckhand must adhere to all United States Coast Guard regulations and company polices.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Perform lookout/navigational watches while underway and safety/anchor/dock watches.
2. Assist with normal maintenance and equipment.
3. Assist with luggage handling and other chores in port.
4. Assist with maintaining records of daily activities as required and monitor the loading and unloading of cargo and passengers.
5. Assist with the safety of passengers and crew.
6. Provide exemplary customer relation skills.
7. Assist with activities such as loading and unloading cargo, Participate in boat fueling, stockpile of supplies and cleaning as needed.
8. Utilize a two way radio to communicate with the Dispatcher.
9. Deckhand must be willing to work five days a weeks, weekends, split shifts, holidays and in all weather conditions.
10. Other duties as assigned to meet the needs of the department.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES:

This is not a supervisory position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Knowledge of the Klamath River and river channel bed.
2. One year experience as a Deckhand or equivalent.
3. Valid Driver’s License.

4. First Aid/CPR required.
5. Must pass pre-employment drug screen, reference checks and background check.
6. Must have sufficiently acute hearing, eyesight and depth perception to meet the demands.
7. Must have excellent public speaking skills; past tour guide experience preferred but not necessary.
8. Must be capable of using escape hatches and boarding /disembarking survival craft unassisted.
9. Obtain Swift Water Rescue Training.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

Prefer high school diploma or GED and one (1) year previous experience in a comparable position or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

4. Maintain First Aid and CPR certification.
5. **LANGUAGE SKILLS:** Must have the ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos, also to write simple correspondence. With ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and small group situations to customers, clients, and other employees of the organization.
6. **REASONING ABILITY:** Apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral and/or diagram form. With ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations.
7. **PHYSICAL DEMANDS:** While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to walk, stand and use hands to finger, handle, or feel. The employee is occasionally required to sit, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl, talk and hear.
