



YUROK TRIBE 2024 FALL FISHERY HARVEST RULES (Summarized for Posting)

SEASON: August 6 through November 30, 2024

TOTAL SUBSISTENCE QUOTA: 5,147 adult Chinook salmon

OPEN DAYS AND HOURS: From 9:00 a.m. Friday through 9:00 a.m. Tuesday of each week.

DRIFT NETTING THE CHUTE: Drift net fishing is allowed in the chute with 30-foot (max. length) throw nets 2-days weekly only, 12:01 a.m. Saturday through midnight Sunday of each week. Drift net fishing in the chute is prohibited after the Coho protection closure begins on September 25. Set nets are never allowed in the chute.

FISH KILL CLOSURE: The Yurok fishery will be closed immediately if there is a determination by the YTFP that a fish kill has begun.

COHO PROTECTION CLOSURE: To protect Coho stocks, which have been listed as “threatened” under the Endangered Species Act, beginning Wednesday, September 25 through November 30, all fishing is prohibited from 9:00 a.m. Monday through 9:00 a.m. Friday and is allowed only from 9:00 a.m. Friday through 9:00 a.m. Monday of each week.
